2 Year IGCSE

IGCSE is the world's most popular international qualification for 14 to 16 year olds. It is recognised across the globe including world's leading universities and employers.

IGCSE are designed for global learners and have been developed in consultation with the international school community, including a large number of teachers and world class academics.

IGCSE is equivalent to GCSE (in the UK), GCE, WAEC, NECO (in Africa) and other similar qualifications around the world. The qualification is recognized by most notable educational institutions around the world.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

A minimum of three years of post-primary education, or other recognised equivalent examinations. In Nigeria, entry will be suitable for students who have completed SSS1 or students who have completed JSS 3 with very good result and testimonials. There is also a mandatory entrance exam to determine students suitability for the programme.

COURSE DURATION:

2 years

ADMISSION GATEWAY:

We offer admissions in October (3 terms) and January (2 terms intensive/fast track)

PROGRESS TO UNIVERSITY

On completion of IGCSE, students can move up to post-16 study like A 'levels or for entry onto undergraduate degree programmes in Universities, polytechnic and other related institutions of higher learning.



The International Advanced Levels (IAL) programmes are globally recognised qualifications which open doors to top local and international universities worldwide. It is designed for students who want to apply to the top UK universities like Oxford and Cambridge.

COURSE AIM

The primary aim of the A'Levels programme is to gain admission into 3- year degree programme in recognised UK universities.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

A minimum of 5 credits in relevant subjects inclusive of English Language and Mathematics (not more than 2 sittings) in WAEC, IGCSE, NECO, GCSE, O' level or other recognised equivalent qualifications.

ADMISSION GATEWAY:

We offer admissions in October (3 terms) and January (2 terms intensive/fast track)

COURSE DURATION: Two Years (6 terms) or 18months (5 terms)

The A'level programme is suitable for students who have spent 5 years In secondary schools and have completed their IGCSE. The first year will be intermediate while the second year will be advanced.

PROGRESS TO UNIVERSITY

International Advanced Level (IAL) qualifications are widely recognised by universities in the UK and worldwide for entry onto undergraduate degree programmes. In some countries, where university degree programme is four years, students with appropriate A' levels can be admitted to second year of the four-year degree programme.

BTC offers University Foundation Programmes specifically for students who needed to study abroad. Under this partnership, students who successfully completed our University Foundation Programme can gain automatic admissions to study with recognised universities abroad. We partner predominantly with Universities in UK, USA, Canada, Australia and other countries.

COURSE AIM:

Every student has an individual learning plan. ILP is a live document that tracks student journey in school and also serves as a benchmark to measure students' performance against key performance criteria.


